

WALK IN YOUR PURPOSE

Jeremiah 29:11 NIV – For I know the plans I have for you, “declares the Lord,” plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

PURPOSE

- Purpose: the reason for which something is done or created or for which something exists.
- You were created by God’s purpose and for His purpose; become aligned with God’s will for your life
- God foreknew your existence; God has a purpose and plan for your life – Jeremiah 1:5-10
- God’s purpose in our lives is not about us; He has a greater purpose in plan for His Kingdom
- Painful experiences can propel you into purpose – Romans 8:28

PASSION

- What do you love to do? Search your heart
- You have spiritual and vocational gifts, talents, abilities, strengths, and an anointing that connects you to your purpose
- You fit into God’s purpose in your own unique way
- Find your passion through positional responsibilities & expectations
- Activated passion brings impact to the people, environment, or generation God has called you to; you flourish when you focus your time, energy and resources in your areas of passion

PARTNERSHIPS

- Understanding your purpose and passion is null without partnerships
- You need the right partnerships; critical to living the life God intended for you:
 - Covenant relationships 1 Samuel 20; Luke 1:39-45; Ruth 1:15-17
 - Wise counsel relationships – Proverbs 13:20
- Look toward the Cross: up and down relationship with God and left to right relationship with others; there’s an interdependency
- Build relationships with people who have similar passions as yours; your association is a preview of your destination; your relationships must be in alignment with your purpose. It’s not the quantity; it’s the quality
- Other people’s gifts will compliment your gift to succeed in your area of calling - Exodus 4:16

PURSUE

- Understand and use what you have in your hand (Exodus 14:15-16)
- Walk in your purpose by making your vision clear and active (Habakkuk 2:2-3)
- You are divinely equipped with all the necessary resources to walk in your purpose

WALK IN YOUR PURPOSE

- Leverage all areas of your life that God has exposed you to: relationships, finances, geographical location, knowledge, etc...
- Pursue Purpose through:
 - Prayer
 - Utilization
 - Reasoning
 - Planning
 - Opposition
 - Success
 - Expectation

PROCLAMATION – Affirm, Decree, and Declare

- Know Who You Are and Whose You Are
- You need an affirmation to repeat daily
- Create a life purpose statement

2. How can we bring God glory through passion; our gifts, talents, and abilities?
3. What are covenant relationships? Why are partnerships important?
4. How does James 2:26 relate to purpose?

8. To walk in purpose fearlessly, confidently, and courageously
9. For God to increase my anointing to walk in purpose
10. For my passion to be ignited to relentlessly pursue my purpose
11. For discernment and strength to fight against the enemy's schemes and tactics that try to limit me from walking in purpose
12. Clarity and understanding of my gifts, talents, and abilities to effectively walk in purpose
